CONTEST NOMINATIONS: 1. WOMEN / PEACE

Posters which are dedicated to peace as a necessary condition for life of a human being. Peace and ecology are essential parts of harmonic world. It's a basis needed for every society to develope and to create something beautiful in the end. We don't want war — we want peace!

2. CHILDREN / HOPE

Posters which are dedicated to children as the future of mankind. Posters introducing eco-thinking to young audience, Posters encouraging adults to care.

3. CATS))) LOVE

Posters reflecting the beauty of the surrounding world, humanity and kindness, calling for coexistence and careful attitude of human to the remains of living nature in urbanized spaces of modern habitat.

4. SPECIAL PROJECT ART OF DATA

For the first time during the triennial there will be held a 48-hour «Hackathon». Designers and IT specialists are invited with joint projects on environmental and social issues: interaction between human and nature, citizens and urban environment.
